“Fall Finale” Show Rules

1. This show is a recognized member of Equine Canada and is governed by its rules. Passports are required for all core divisions, **including equitation classes**, except Hack Division. 2010 Equine Canada ‘Silver’ Competitive Sport License, OEF & THJA membership cards are required for riders and owners. If you or the owner of the horse/pony do not have an EC Silver Sport License you will be required to purchase a temporary membership. Your points will not count for this show with a temporary EC Sport License. **Adult Amateur riders must have Amateur Status on their Equine Canada membership card. These will be checked.**
2. **Modified Child/Adult Hunter** – the Rider may **NOT** enter in any other division **at that show with the exception of the Hack Division.** They may also enter in their applicable equitation class on the flat only. **The horse may, however, with another rider, enter in another division(s) at that show. EC, OEF and THJA memberships are required for owner and rider. Passports required.** **Modified Child/Adult Hunter Medal** – Equitation class, will follow the Modified Child/Adult Hunter Division. **Riders can walk the course. It will consist of an equitation class over fences – 2’9”- with the top 10 riders being called back to do a phase on the flat. The tack remains the same for the flat phase. Only Modified Child/Adult riders eligible.**
3. **Hors Concours:** Not permitted.
4. **Rider Falls:** Remounting not allowed.
5. **Show Committee:** The committee reserves the right to cancel, postpone, combine or reschedule any classes it deems necessary.
6. **2’6” Open Hunter Division (New in 2010) Open to Horses only.** This is a pilot project. **Cross entry into any other division for horse/rider combination is not allowed.** This division is a core program and will qualify for the 2010 Championships.
7. **New Jumper Divisions (2010) -- .85 meter jumpers. Open to everyone**
8. **1meter Training Jumpers** – This division will run concurrently with the 1meter Junior/Amateur Jumper with one course walk. **NO PONIES ALLOWED.** The points will be separate. **1 meter Junior/Amateur (formerly Child/Adult).** Open to ponies ridden by Juniors and horses. **HORSE/RIDER COMBINATIONS will be limited to ONE of these divisions at this height.**
9. **1.15 meter Trillium Jumper** – Junior/Amateurs can cross enter into this division. **PLEASE NOTE:** Horses are limited to two (2) jumper divisions plus the Jumper Medal, if eligible, plus any other non-core miscellaneous classes.
10. **Helmets:** Anyone mounted on a horse/pony, including foreign competitors, must wear ASTM or BSI approved Helmets with safety harness correctly fastened at all times while mounted on the competitive grounds.
11. **Dogs:** Please refrain from bringing dogs. If a must, please keep on leash. There will be a fine for loose dogs. **Please clean up after them if they come with you.**
12. NSF cheques will be assessed a \$50 surcharge. Cancelled entries and any refunds will be assessed a \$25 plus GST administration fee.
13. **Pony’s Measurements:** To obtain a measurement card, pony must be measured at an EC sanctioned competition in which it is competing.
14. **Jumper Medal** - For the flat phase all tack remains the same as in the over fences phase with the exception of whips and spurs
15. **Saddle Pads in the Hunter Ring** – White saddle-shaped pads or sheepskin.
16. **Bitless Bridles** – Not permitted in the Hunter ring.
17. **Abuse** – Abuse of the horse is strictly forbidden. Excessive use of a whip – a horse should never be hit more than THREE times for any one incident.

19. **Food and Refreshments available on the grounds.**

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.

Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.

Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.

Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.

Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.

Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.

Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition.

Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

WARM-UP PROCEDURE FOR SILVER (TRILLIUM) SHOW

PLEASE NOTE: Open Schooling cards (Judged) will only be open to competitors showing in that ring on that day. Cards will be open all day. Schooling cards (Judged) will not be open during Equitation classes. There will not be an Open Card (Judged) during Low Hunter or Modified Child/Adult Hunter. There will be a regular open warm-up prior to the commencement of Low Hunter and Modified Child/Adult Hunter for riders competing in these classes only from 7:15 to 10 minutes before the commencement of the classes. Open Schooling Card (Judged) will start with the Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter riders. For Sm/Med Pony Riders there will be an a regular warm-up set at 2'3" and all lines at 72', from 7:15 to 10 minutes prior to the commencement of that ring. The Open Card will commence after the Sm/Med pony division.

ENTRY CANCELLATIONS

- ✓ Entries cancelled in writing 24 hours prior to the first class entered, with prior medical documentation, will be assessed the administration fee.
- ✓ Cancelled entries providing notification 24 hours in advance without a veterinary certificate will be assessed a \$25 cancellation fee and the administration fees.
- ✓ There will be no refund for classes cancelled on, or scratched from the day of competition for any reason. You may change from one class to another, or change from one division to another.
- ✓ All '**no show**' entries will be charged a \$40 cancellation fee and the administration fees. All accounts must be settled prior to the next show (whether at the same show facility or another), otherwise entries will be denied, and no points will be awarded.
